2025 is well on the way! At the Delft ECD Project, we are witnessing great progress with our roof-fixing initiative and we would like to share our news and invite you to celebrate the progress with us!

Roof fixing feedback

After the 2024 Cape Town winter, the need to repair the roofs of crèches in our project that had been damaged by floods became increasingly important. We prioritised the damage according to cost and necessity and repaired the first two roofs of Tiny Educare and Young Eagles Nest. See our [Dec'24 Newsletter](#).

This year, we initiated the third roof-fixing project at Agapé Educare. This project proved to be much bigger than the previous two. The work included the complete removal and building of a new roof, the repair of the bathrooms, the increase of ventilation and lighting through installing larger windows, as well as the installation of partitioning to divide the different age groups according to the specifications of the Department of Education. Agapé Educare is now completely transformed! The school is neat and very beautiful!

- The principle of Agapé Educare expressed how she asked God for 2025 to bring about change in her crèche. Due to all the leaks in her roof, she had many setbacks and difficulties. With the transformation of her crèche, God has already brought great change!
- During the two weeks that the roof was being repaired, four individuals visited the principal of Agapé to share how the crèche has positively impacted them or their children. They spoke about the thorough education their children received at the crèche and the significant influence it has had on their lives. Donations:

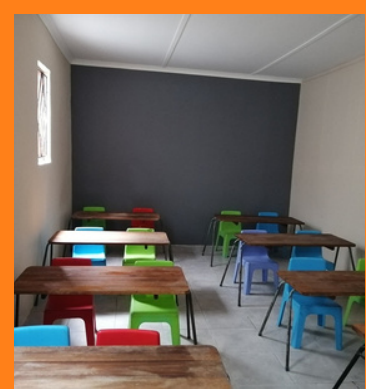
In February, Mama Nomfundo received a donation of 300 kg of non-perishable food, valued at R5000, from a generous donor. This contribution will provide weekday meals for 64 children for an entire month.

Additionally, generous financial provision has made it possible to start a significant roof and crèche renovation at Angels Day Care for Special Needs. Bernice and Adrian run an amazing school that caters to children with special needs. The provision of a new roof and repair to storm damage will ensure a warm and secure winter for these children in the future.

Anxiety, fatigue, and concerns about these challenges are widespread.
